

Fire safety guidelines for visitors

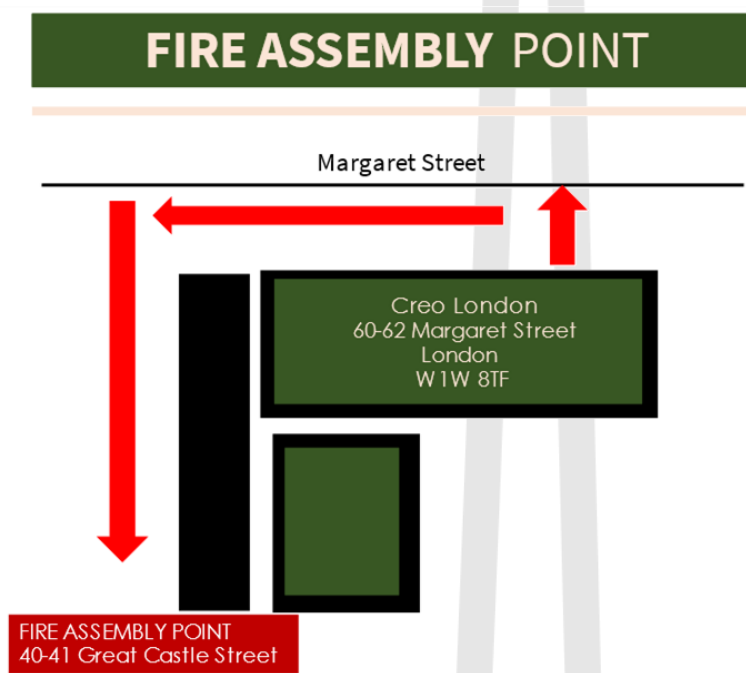
Welcome to Resuscitation Council UK.

Please take a moment to review the following fire safety

guidelines: **Emergency procedures**

1. **Evacuation routes:** Familiarise yourself with the nearest exits and evacuation routes. Maps are posted in the office and throughout the building.
2. **Fire alarms:** The fire alarms are tested on Fridays between 10:30 and 11:00. If the alarm is continuous or sounded at any other time, please evacuate immediately using the stairs and do not stop to collect personal belongings. Do not use the elevator.
3. **Assembly points:** Proceed to the designated assembly point located to the rear of the building, across from Oxford Market. Please report to the Resuscitation Council Fire Warden.



Accessibility

- If you require assistance or have mobility issues, please let us know immediately on arrival at the office.

Additional information

- **No smoking:** Smoking and vaping is prohibited inside the building.
- **Fire extinguishers:** Fire extinguishers are located near the lift on all floors of the building and in the reception area of the ground floor. Use them only if you are trained and the fire is small.
- **First aid:** First aid kits are available at reception and in the office. Please report any incidents to a Resuscitation Council UK staff member.
- **Sign in/out:** All visitors must sign in and out at reception.
